
We will be joined by the mission team from FBC in Cambridge, OH.

The Board met in March to discuss the following items:

- Completed policies for the new PTO (paid time off) state law.
- Accepted the completed Staff Policy Handbook
- Update on lawn equipment servicing and repairs (needed 2 tires repaired and a new seatbelt)
- Accepted a bid from Team Green for lawn treatment
- Parking lot gravel completed at nearly \$1000 under bid
- Seeding the bare patches in the lawn has been completed
- Researching options for printer problems
- Discussed advertising
- Planning for staff evaluations

Pastor Jon reported that he is making plans for outings with the youth. Visitation with shut-ins and the monthly service at Grand Prairie are going well. He is making plans for a mission trip to North St. Louis July 14-19 in coordination with Catholic Charities. The Salvation Army will provide housing for the week. It will involve remodeling work. He also expressed the need for another volunteer van driver for Sunday mornings.
